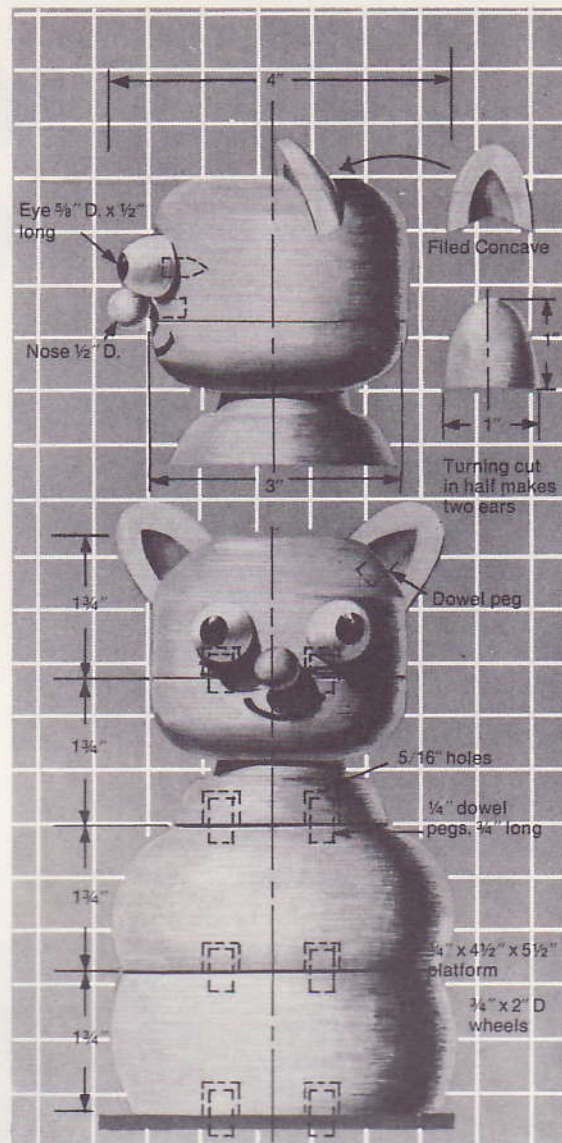
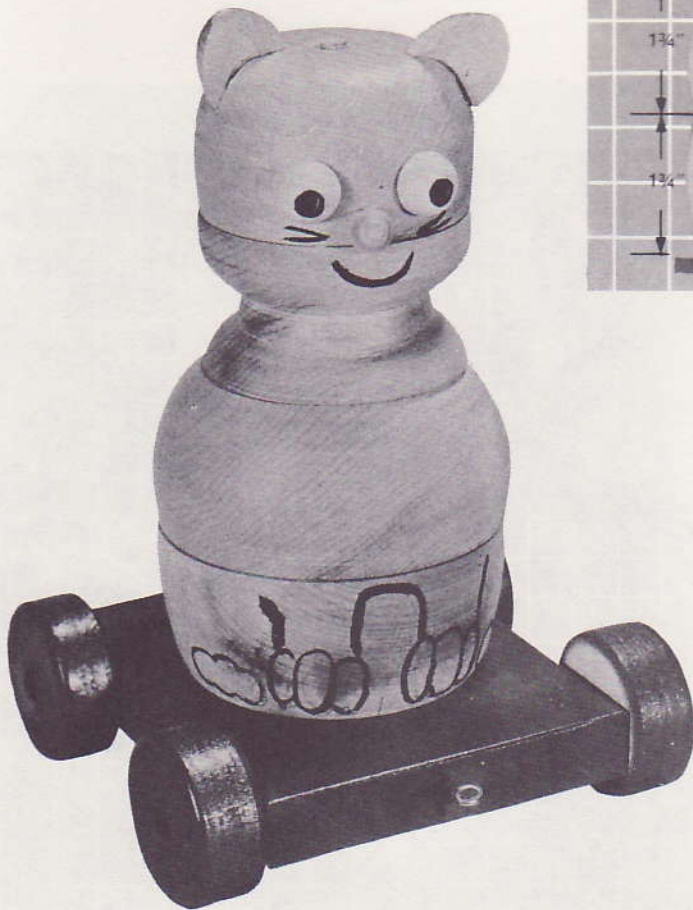


A pair of pegs in each section makes the parts self-aligning when they are stacked in the proper order

■ STACKIN' CAT is turned as a single piece, even though it consists of four $1\frac{3}{4}$ -in. separate blocks pegged together (without glue) and mounted between lathe centers. After turning, holes in one section are enlarged slightly so that pegs will fit freely. Ears and nose are separate turnings; eyes are rubber furniture bumpers. The cat is finished natural in nontoxic paints and varnish and rides on a wagon fitted with a pull string. Pegs in the wagon keep the cat from falling off. All pegs should be glued or can be simply forced in undersize holes.
